

IF YOU WORK AT THE RIGHT INSTITUTION, YOU CAN APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDS.

Did you know the Federal Government can help pay off your student loans? It's true. The program provides tax-free grants for psychiatrists who make a two-year commitment to provide mental health care in underserved communities.

And best of all, psychiatrists practicing in several of our correctional facilities are eligible to apply.

Full-Time loan recipients working in a Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA) with a HPSA score of 14 or higher may receive up to \$60,000 to pay for qualifying student loans in exchange for a two-year service commitment with an approved site. Those working in a HPSA with a score of 13 or below may receive up to \$40,000.
