Q 1: "Does Section 11.2.1.2 request only 3 relevant projects for the team as a whole, or does it limit the response to 3 projects per joint venture or associate IPD team member?"

A 1: Section 11.2.1.3 – suggest providing three (3) from the General Contractor and three (3) from the Lead Architect from each IPD Team proposing.

Q 2: "The 1 page per project limitation expressed in Section 11.2.1.2, when combined with the 10pt font minimum expressed in Section 13, may not provide adequate space to address each project in the level of detail requested. Can the limit be increased to 2 pages per project to allow more detailed information to be presented?"

A 2: Two (2) pages per project is the requirement.

Q 3: "Does the 50-page limit referenced in Section 13 restrict the submittal to 50 page faces, or 50 individual sheets which could be printed on both sides?"

A 3: Fifty-page limit refers to 50 single sided (face) pages; only single sided pages will be accepted.

Q 4: 1/2" x 11" limitation: "Can charts or diagrams such as the organization chart, schedule, personnel matrix, or other process graphics be submitted as an 11"x17" folded page?
If so, would this count as a single page or as two pages?"

A 4: Yes, a maximum of five (5) 11" x 17" pages will be acceptable for charts or diagrams.

Q 5: Is it expected that the Element Team Leaders are supposed to be part of the Core Group?

A 5: No, the Element Team Leaders are not part of the Core Group.

Q 6: Would you please send me the final version of the solicitation notice? I am unable to locate the final version on the www.cprinc.org website.

A 6: Please find attached. It is located in Projects, RFPs, the fourth document down entitled "APR RFP for Integrated Project Delivery and Design Build Services Solicitation Notice."

Q 7: Is this solicitation for a contract that has been awarded to URS/BLL from CPR Inc.?

A 7: URS/BLL Joint Venture was awarded a Consulting Services Agreement from the CPR for Program Management Services. Please refer to the RFQP for more information.

Q 8: We have looked online and did not find a “revised” RFQ dated April 25, 2008. Are we missing something?

A 8: The RFQP was not revised. The Solicitation Notice originally posted was replaced with the correct, final version that was published on 4/15/08 with the RFQP. When in doubt, refer to the RFQP and the Addendas.

Q 9: Can you please clarify that the solicitation notice on the website (the 4th down on the web page) is the current document?

A 9: Yes, this is the current document.

Q 10: Is this [Information Outreach Session] in place of the preproposal or in addition to?

A 10: If I understand your question, you are asking if this is in place of the Mandatory Pre-Submittal Conference or in addition to. These are in addition to the Mandatory Pre-Submittal Conference providing an opportunity to receive general information regarding the CPR Program and the RFQP. Attendance at one of the Informal Outreach Sessions does not relieve interested IPD Teams from attending the Mandatory Pre-Submittal Conference.

Q 11: Would there be any room for a “Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise” DVBE company to work on this project?

A 11: There are no advantages or disadvantages to a DVBE company for this particular project. All firms are welcome. Please encourage firms to attend one of the two Informal Outreach Sessions shown on the attached Addenda to learn more about the CPR Program and the project.

Q 12: Are civil engineers, surveyors, traffic engineers or construction inspectors among the disciplines sought?

A 12: Yes, all disciplines are encouraged to respond, but proposal to the CPR will only be accepted from qualifying IPD Teams & their respective firms.
