BACKGROUND

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), California Correctional Health Care Services (CCHCS), is requesting offers for a Project Manager (PM) to support the Federated Data Center (FDC) project and related sub-projects. The PM will provide management support to complete design efforts and implementation of the FDC storage for application migration, local backups, and offsite replication.

Contractor will report to CCHCS' Deputy Chief Information Officer (DCIO), Infrastructure, or designee(s). In submitting an offer vendor must comply with the instructions found herein.

The term of proposed Agreement is targeted for March 26, 2012 through March 25, 2013. CCHCS reserves the option to extend the Agreement for up to two (2) years at the same hourly rate and/or to add additional funds up to the maximum CMAS threshold. The contract award is subject to availability of funds approved for this purpose and renewal of the California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) for IT Consulting Services.

All offers must be signed by an authorized officer of the company or firm who has legal and binding authority. By submitting an offer, your firm agrees to the terms and conditions stated in this Request for Offer (RFO) and in accordance with your authorized Leveraged Procurement Agreement (i.e., CMAS contract).
