**QUESTIONS/STATEMENTS AND ANSWERS**

1. Question(s)/Statement(s):

“Please describe the current state of the EHR plan and implementation.”

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

The electronic medical record (EMR) project is comprised of several funded sub-projects and each sub-project implements a portion of CPHCS' EMR solution. Each EMR sub-project has distinct current states for planning and implementation.

2. Question(s)/Statement(s):

“Which CPHCS departments or functions have implemented EHR?

Which departments or functions have yet to implement EHR?

What is the timetable for the remaining implementation?”

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

CPHCS performs services at thirty-three (33) correctional facilities and headquarters. Components of CPHCS' EMR solution (i.e., EMR sub-project[s]) have begun phased deployment to all thirty-three (33) institutions.

CPHCS anticipates EMR implementation completion by June, 2014.

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

A number of solutions have been selected for various aspects of CPHCS' EMR solution as a "best of breed" system design approach. Currently, all EMR components have begun integration to allow a common view of a patient's medical record.

CPHCS' EMR solution integration is not yet fully implemented. CPHCS anticipates complete EMR implementation by June, 2014.
