BACKGROUND

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), California Correctional Health Care Services (CCHCS), is requesting offers for Database Administrators (DBAs) to assist with the Enterprise Database Consolidation and Standardization Project. Contractors will report to CCHCS' Deputy Chief Information Officer (DCIO) Health Care Information Solutions (HCIS) or designee(s).

The proposed term of the ensuing Agreement is June 28, 2013 through June 28, 2014. CCHCS reserves the option to extend the Agreement for up to twenty-four (24) additional months at the same deliverable rate(s) and/or to add additional funds up to the maximum California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) threshold. The contract award is subject to availability of funds approved for this purpose.

In submitting an offer Offeror agrees to the terms and conditions stated in the Request for Offer and in accordance with the Offeror's authorized CMAS Agreement. All offers must be signed by an authorized officer of the company or firm who has legal and binding authority.
